

CHARLES COUNTY SKATEPARK RULES

- Skatepark opens at 9:00 AM daily and closes at dusk. Park will remain closed when elements or equipment surface is wet, icy, snow covered or under repair.
- The use of bicycles or scooters is prohibited.
- SKATING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- While on skating surface, ALL SKATERS are required to wear a helmet. Elbow pads, knee pads and wrist guards are recommended.
- Skaters under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Do not use ramps/elements that are beyond your skill level.
- One person per element at a time. One person per board.
- Skating is allowed in authorized areas only.
- Skater etiquette is expected at all times.
- Profanity and recklessness will not be tolerated.
- No glass containers permitted in park.
- Food and drink are not allowed within the skating area.
- Participants must enter through the designated entrance gate.
- Tagging/defacing park property is a crime. Vandals will be prosecuted.
- Alcohol, drugs and smoking are prohibited in the park.
- Fighting or other aggressive or disruptive behavior will result in ejection from the park.
- Personal music devices (Ipod, MP3 player, cell phone) will be allowed with the use of headphones. NO amplified music allowed.
- No loitering or trespassing when skatepark is closed.
- Any infraction of the park rules will result in loss of skatepark privileges.
